## **FLORAL SCROLL ENAMELLED GOLD CROSS BY JOHN PAUL COOPER**

Cross of Latin form with flared ends, to one side green and red guilloché leaf motifs on an opaque light green ground, a central oblique square with blue leaves on a turquoise enamel ground and beaded gold border, the reverse with red, green, blue and pink guilloché leaves and scrolling gold wirework stems all on an opaque black ground, centred by a square turquoise enamelled frame, all edged with zigzag incised fluted rims surmounted by a hinged openwork trefoil suspension loop with triple bead clusters.

John Paul Cooper (1869-1933) was an architect and a leading craftsman in the Arts and Crafts Movement, specialising in

metalwork and jewellery.
